A BILL

For the relief of Sylvester Flis.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. GRANT OF NATURALIZATION TO SYLVESTER**
4 **FLIS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
6 sion of law, Sylvester Flis shall be naturalized as a citizen
7 of the United States upon the filing of the appropriate
8 application and upon being administered the oath of re-
9 nunciation and allegiance in an appropriate ceremony pur-
10 suant to section 337 of the Immigration and Nationality
11 Act.

1 (b) DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION AND PAYMENT OF
2 FEES.—Subsection (a) shall apply only if the application
3 for naturalization is filed with appropriate fees within 1
4 year after the date of the enactment of this Act.
