A BILL

For the relief of Belinda McGregor.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
 2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENCE.**

4 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, for pur-
 5 poses of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
 6 1101 et seq.), Belinda McGregor shall be held and consid-
 7 ered to have been lawfully admitted to the United States
 8 ~~for permanent residence~~ *selected for a diversity immigrant*

1 *visa for fiscal year 1998* as of the date of the enactment
2 of this Act upon payment of the required visa fee.

3 **SEC. 2. REDUCTION OF NUMBER OF AVAILABLE VISAS.**

4 Upon the granting of permanent residence to Belinda
5 McGregor as provided in this Act, the Secretary of State
6 shall instruct the proper officer to reduce by one number
7 during the current fiscal year the total number of immi-
8 grant visas available to natives of the country of the alien's
9 birth under section 203~~(a)~~(c) of the Immigration and Na-
10 tionality Act (8 U.S.C. 1153 ~~(a)~~(c)).
