A BILL

To designate the United States courthouse located in New Haven, Connecticut, as the “Richard C. Lee United States Courthouse”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF RICHARD C. LEE UNITED**
4 **STATES COURTHOUSE.**

5 The United States courthouse located in New Haven,
6 Connecticut, shall be known and designated as the “Rich-
7 ard C. Lee United States Courthouse”.

1 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

2 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
3 paper, or other record of the United States to the United
4 States courthouse referred to in section 1 shall be deemed
5 to be a reference to the “Richard C. Lee United States
6 Courthouse”.
