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## A BILL

To provide a 6-month extension of safety programs under  
ISTEA.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Short ISTEA Exten-  
5 sion Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. 6-MONTH EXTENSION OF HIGHWAY SAFETY PRO-**  
7 **GRAMS.**

8 (a) NHTSA HIGHWAY SAFETY PROGRAMS.—Section  
9 2005(1) of the Intermodal Surface Transportation Effi-  
10 ciency Act of 1991 is amended—

1           (1) by striking “1992 and” and inserting  
2           “1992,”; and

3           (2) by striking “1997.” and inserting “1997,  
4           and \$58,929,000 for the period beginning October 1,  
5           1997, and ending March 31, 1998.”.

6           (b)   ALCOHOL-IMPAIRED   DRIVING   COUNTER-  
7 MEASURES.—Section 410 of title 23, United States Code,  
8 is amended—

9           (1) by striking “5 fiscal” in subsection (c) and  
10          inserting “6 fiscal”;

11          (2) by striking “and fifth” in subsection (c)(3)  
12          and inserting “fifth, and sixth”;

13          (3) by striking “two” in subsection (d)(2)(B)  
14          and inserting “3”; and

15          (4) by striking “1997.” in subsection (j) and  
16          inserting “1997, and \$12,500,000 for the period be-  
17          ginning October 1, 1997, and ending March 31,  
18          1998.”.

19          (c)   NATIONAL   DRIVER   REGISTER.—Section  
20 30308(a) of title 49, United States Code, is amended—

21          (1) by striking “1994 and” and inserting  
22          “1994,”; and

23          (2) by striking “1997.” and inserting “1997,  
24          and \$802,500 for the period beginning October 1,  
25          1997, and ending March 31, 1998.”.

1 **SEC. 3. 6-MONTH EXTENSION OF MOTOR CARRIER SAFETY**  
2 **PROGRAM.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 31104(a) is amended to  
4 read as follows:

5 “(a) GENERAL.—Subject to section 9503(c)(1) of the  
6 Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (26 U.S.C. 9503(c)(1)),  
7 there are available from the Highway Trust Fund (except  
8 the Mass Transit Account) for the Secretary of Transpor-  
9 tation to insure obligations to carry out section 31102 of  
10 this title, not more than \$40,000,000 for the period begin-  
11 ning October 1, 1997, and ending March 31, 1998.”.

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
