Mr. JOHNSON introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Agriculture, Nutrition, and Forestry

A BILL

To amend the Child Nutrition Act of 1966 to expand the School Breakfast Program in elementary schools.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Meals for Achievement
5 Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. EXPANSION OF SCHOOL BREAKFAST PROGRAM.**

7 Section 4(b)(1)(B) of the Child Nutrition Act of 1966
8 (42 U.S.C. 1773(b)(1)(B)) is amended—

9 (1) in the first sentence, by striking “for each
10 free breakfast” and inserting “for each breakfast

1 served in an elementary school and each free break-
2 fast served in a school other than an elementary
3 school”;

4 (2) in the second sentence, by inserting “served
5 in a school other than an elementary school” after
6 “reduced price breakfast”; and

7 (3) in the third sentence, by inserting “in a
8 school other than an elementary school” after
9 “served”.
