## A BILL

For the relief of Alexandre Malofienko, Olga Matsko, and their son, Vladimir Malofienko.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENCE.**

4       Notwithstanding any other provision of law, for pur-  
5       poses of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.  
6       1101 et seq.), Alexandre Malofienko, Olga Matsko, and  
7       their son, Vladimir Malofienko, shall be held and consid-  
8       ered to have been lawfully admitted to the United States  
9       for permanent residence as of the date of the enactment  
10      of this Act upon payment of the required visa fees.

1 **SEC. 2. REDUCTION OF NUMBER OF AVAILABLE VISAS.**

2       Upon the granting of permanent residence to  
3 Alexandre Malofienko, Olga Matsko, and their son, Vladi-  
4 mir Malofienko, as provided in this Act, the Secretary of  
5 State shall instruct the proper officer to reduce by the ap-  
6 propriate number during the current fiscal year the total  
7 number of immigrant visas available to natives of the  
8 country of the aliens' birth under section 203(a) of the  
9 Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1153(a)).
