## AN ACT

For the relief of Kerantha Poole-Christian.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. CLASSIFICATION AS A CHILD UNDER THE IMMI-**  
2 **GRATION AND NATIONALITY ACT.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—In the administration of the Im-  
4 migration and Nationality Act, Kerantha Poole-Christian  
5 shall be classified as a child within the meaning of section  
6 101(b)(1)(E) of such Act, upon approval of a petition filed  
7 on her behalf by Clifton or Linette Christian, citizens of  
8 the United States, pursuant to section 204 of such Act.

9 (b) LIMITATION.—No natural parent, brother, or sis-  
10 ter, if any, of Kerantha Poole-Christian shall, by virtue  
11 of such relationship, be accorded any right, privilege, or  
12 status under the Immigration and Nationality Act.
