1 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF JOSEPH P. KINNEARY**
2 **UNITED STATES COURTHOUSE.**

3 The Federal building and United States courthouse
4 located at 85 Marconi Boulevard in Columbus, Ohio, shall
5 be known and designated as the “Joseph P. Kinneary
6 United States Courthouse”.

7 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

8 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
9 paper, or other record of the United States to the Federal
10 building and United States courthouse referred to in sec-
11 tion 1 shall be deemed to be a reference to the “Joseph
12 P. Kinneary United States Courthouse”.
