## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on organic luminescent  
pigments, dyes, and fibers for security applications.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF DUTY ON CER-**  
4                   **TAIN ORGANIC PIGMENTS, DYES, AND FI-**  
5                   **BERS.**

6       (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
7       the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
8       amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
9       new heading:

“	9902.32.04	Organic luminescent pigments, dyes, and fibers for security applications (provided for in subheading 3204.90.00) .....	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2001	”.

1           (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by  
2 subsection (a) shall apply with respect to goods entered,  
3 or withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after  
4 the date that is 15 days after the date of enactment of  
5 this Act.
