1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SUSPENSION OF DUTY ON PARTS FOR USE IN**

4 **THE MANUFACTURE OF LOUDSPEAKERS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
6 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
7 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
8 new subheading:

“	9902.85.18	Parts for use in the manufacture of loudspeakers (provided for in sub-heading 8518.90.80)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2002	”.

1 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or
3 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
4 the 15th day after the date of enactment of this Act.
