3 **SECTION 1. LABELING REQUIREMENT.**

4 Section 204(a) of the Alcoholic Beverage Labeling
5 Act of 1988 (27 U.S.C. 215(a)) is amended by striking
6 “may cause health problems” and inserting “may lead to
7 alcoholism. (3) Moderate consumption of alcoholic bev-
8 erages may cause health problems such as hypertension
9 and breast cancer”.
