## A BILL

To revise the boundaries of the George Washington Birthplace National Monument.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ADDITION TO NATIONAL MONUMENT.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—The boundaries of the George  
5 Washington Birthplace National Monument are modified  
6 to include the area comprising approximately 85 acres,  
7 generally known as “George Washington’s Ferry Farm”,  
8 in Stafford County, Virginia, and located across the Rap-  
9 pahannock River from Fredericksburg, Virginia, as gen-  
10 erally depicted on the map entitled “George Washington

1 Birthplace National Monument Boundary Map”, num-  
2 bered 322/80020 and dated May 1998.

3 (b) MAP.—The map described in subsection (a) shall  
4 be on file and available for public inspection in the appro-  
5 priate offices of the National Park Service.

6 (c) ADMINISTRATION.—The area described in sub-  
7 section (a) shall be managed—

8 (1) in accordance with the provisions of law  
9 generally applicable to the units of the National  
10 Park System, including the Act of August 25, 1916  
11 (39 Stat. 565, chapter 408; 16 U.S.C. 1 et seq.),  
12 and the Act of August 21, 1935 (49 Stat. 666,  
13 chapter 593; 16 U.S.C. 461 et seq.);

14 (2) to preserve the cultural and natural re-  
15 sources of the area that are associated with the boy-  
16 hood home of George Washington; and

17 (3) to interpret those resources to enhance pub-  
18 lic understanding.
