Mr. BURNS introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources

A BILL

To amend the boundaries of Grant-Kohrs Ranch National Historic Site in the State of Montana.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Grant-Kohrs Ranch
5 National Historic Site Boundary Adjustment Act of
6 1998”.

7 **SEC. 2. ADDITIONS TO GRANT-KOHR'S RANCH NATIONAL**
8 **HISTORIC SITE.**

9 The Act entitled “An Act to authorize the establish-
10 ment of the Grant-Kohrs Ranch National Historic Site in

1 the State of Montana, and for other purposes”, approved
2 August 25, 1972 (86 Stat. 632), is amended by striking
3 the last sentence in the first section and inserting: “The
4 boundary of the National Historic Site shall be as gen-
5 erally described on a map entitled, “Boundary Map,
6 Grant-Kohrs Ranch National Historic Site”, numbered
7 80030–B, and dated January, 1998, which shall be on file
8 and available for public inspection in the local and Wash-
9 ington, District of Columbia, offices of the National Park
10 Service, Department of the Interior.”.
