Mr. SPECTER introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred
to the Committee on Labor and Human Resources

A BILL

For the relief of Paul G. Finnerty and Nancy Finnerty
of Scranton, Pennsylvania.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN EARNINGS DEEMED TO BE COM-**
4 **PENSATION FOR PURPOSES OF RAILROAD**
5 **RETIREMENT.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—For purposes of the computation
7 of any annuity for Paul G. Finnerty and Nancy Finnerty
8 of Scranton, Pennsylvania, under sections 3 and 4 of the
9 Railroad Retirement Act of 1974 (42 U.S.C. 231b; 231c),
10 any pay received by such Paul G. Finnerty for service per-

1 formed during the period beginning January 1, 1986,
2 through January 1, 1994, by reason of his employment
3 with the Department of Defense at the Tobyhanna Army
4 Depot, shall be deemed to be compensation.

5 (b) RULE OF CONSTRUCTION.—Nothing in sub-
6 section (a) shall be construed as increasing the years of
7 service for such Paul G. Finnerty in computing any annu-
8 ity for the individuals described in subsection (a).

9 (c) APPLICATION.—The Railroad Retirement Board
10 shall apply the deeming requirement described in sub-
11 section (a) from the date of commencement of any annuity
12 paid by such Board to the individuals referred to in sub-
13 section (a).

14 (d) ADJUSTMENT.—If, after the application of sub-
15 section (a), the Railroad Retirement Board determines
16 that an adjustment to any annuity paid to the individuals
17 referred to in subsection (a) before the date of enactment
18 of this Act is required, such Board shall make a lump-
19 sum payment equal to such required adjustment to such
20 individuals by not later than 90 days after the date of
21 enactment of this Act.
