A BILL

To direct the Secretary of the Interior to make technical corrections to a map relating to the Coastal Barrier Resources System.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. FINDINGS AND PURPOSE.**

4 ~~(a) FINDINGS.—Congress finds that—~~

1 (1) Coastal Barrier Resources System unit FL-
2 35P was designated under the Coastal Barrier Im-
3 provement Act of 1990 (Public Law 101-591) to in-
4 clude Florida State conservation land within the
5 Coastal Barrier Resources System;

6 (2) unit FL-35P is an “otherwise protected
7 area”, a designation that was intended to include
8 land held for conservation purposes;

9 (3) the boundary of unit FL-35P runs through
10 a portion of the Ocean Reef Harbor Course South
11 development, which was in existence on the date of
12 enactment of the 1990 Act;

13 (4) at the time unit FL-35P was designated, 9
14 residences were located in the portion of the develop-
15 ment that was included within the boundaries of the
16 unit;

17 (5) the 11.7 acres comprising that portion are
18 not held for conservation purposes, and are not an
19 inholding within conservation land;

20 (6) the United States Fish and Wildlife Service
21 has received certificates of occupancy and cor-
22 responding plat maps from Monroe County, Florida,
23 verifying that a portion of unit FL-35P was devel-
24 oped, and accordingly that the portion referred to in

1 paragraph (5) was mistakenly included in the Coast-
 2 al Barrier Resources System; and

3 ~~(7) modification of the boundary of unit FL-~~
 4 ~~35P to exclude the 11.7-acre parcel referred to in~~
 5 ~~paragraph (5) would constitute a valid technical cor-~~
 6 ~~rection.~~

7 (b) PURPOSE.—The purpose of this Act is to make
 8 a technical correction to unit FL-35P of the Coastal Bar-
 9 rier Resources System to exclude from the unit the 11.7-
 10 acre parcel of developed property that was mistakenly in-
 11 cluded in the unit.

12 **SEC. 2. CORRECTIONS TO MAP.**

13 **SECTION 1. CORRECTIONS TO MAP.**

14 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 30 days after the
 15 date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of the Interior
 16 shall make such corrections to the map described in sub-
 17 section (b) as are necessary to ensure that depictions of
 18 areas on the map are consistent with the depictions of
 19 areas appearing on the map entitled “Amendments to the
 20 Coastal Barrier Resources System”, dated August 31,
 21 1998, and on file with the Secretary. *section (b) as are*
 22 *necessary to exclude—*

23 *(1) the lots that, as of the date of enactment of*
 24 *this Act, are located on Harbor Island Drive and*
 25 *Baker Road; and*

1 (2) *the adjacent body of water;*
2 *within the Ocean Reef Harbor Course South development.*

3 (b) MAP DESCRIBED.—The map described in this
4 subsection is the map that—

5 (1) is included in a set of maps entitled “Coast-
6 al Barrier Resources System”, dated October 24,
7 1990; and

8 (2) relates to unit FL-35P of the Coastal Bar-
9 rier Resources System.

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
