3 **SECTION 1. CASH PAYMENT TO FEDERAL EMPLOYEES FOR**
4 **PARKING SPACES.**

5 (a) SHORT TITLE.—This Act may be cited as the
6 “Federal Employee Flexibility Act of 1998”.

1 (b) IN GENERAL.—Section 7905(b)(2) of title 5,
2 United States Code, is amended—

3 (1) in subparagraph (B) by striking “and”
4 after the semicolon;

5 (2) in subparagraph (C) by striking the pe-
6 riod and inserting a semicolon and “and”; and

7 (3) by adding at the end the following:

8 “(D) taxable cash payment to an employee
9 in lieu of an agency-provided parking space.”.
