## A BILL

To provide certain secondary school students with eligibility for certain campus-based student assistance under title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SECONDARY SCHOOL STUDENTS IN VOCA-**  
4 **TIONAL OR TECHNICAL PROGRAMS.**

5 Section 484 of the Higher Education Act of 1965 (20  
6 U.S.C. 1091) is amended by adding at the end the follow-  
7 ing:

8 “(s) SECONDARY SCHOOL STUDENTS IN VOCA-  
9 TIONAL OR TECHNICAL PROGRAMS.—Notwithstanding

1 subsection (a)(1) or any other provision of law, an institu-  
2 tion of higher education that awards an associate degree  
3 may award a secondary school student assistance under  
4 the provisions of subpart 3 of part A, part C, and part  
5 E, of this title that are not inconsistent with this sub-  
6 section, if the student is—

7           “(1) from a low-income family; and

8           “(2) concurrently enrolled in a secondary  
9           school, and in a vocational or technical program at  
10          the institution, for the period for which the assist-  
11          ance is sought.”.
