5 fined by section 2 of the Commemorative Works Act (40
6 U.S.C. 1002)) shall expire August 10, 2000, notwith-
7 standing the time period limitation specified in section
8 10(b) of the Commemorative Works Act (40 U.S.C.
9 1010(b)).
