3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

4 The Federal building and United States courthouse
5 located at 475 Mulberry Street in Macon, Georgia, shall

1 be known and designated as the “William Augustus Bootle
2 Federal Building and United States Courthouse”.

3 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

4 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
5 paper, or other record of the United States to the Federal
6 building and United States courthouse referred to in sec-
7 tion 1 shall be deemed to be a reference to the “William
8 Augustus Bootle Federal Building and United States
9 Courthouse”.
