Mr. CAMPBELL introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources

A BILL

To provide for the expansion of the Eagles Nest Wilderness within the Arapaho National Forest and the White River National Forest, Colorado, to include land known as the Slate Creek Addition.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SLATE CREEK ADDITION TO EAGLES NEST WIL-**
4 **DERNESS, ARAPAHO AND WHITE RIVER NA-**
5 **TIONAL FORESTS, COLORADO.**

6 (a) SLATE CREEK ADDITION.—If, before December
7 31, 2000, the United States acquires the parcel of land
8 described in subsection (b)—

1 (1) on acquisition of the parcel, the parcel shall
2 be included in and managed as part of the Eagles
3 Nest Wilderness designated by Public Law 94–352
4 (16 U.S.C. 1132 note; 90 Stat. 870); and

5 (2) the Secretary of Agriculture shall adjust the
6 boundaries of the Eagles Nest Wilderness to reflect
7 the inclusion of the parcel.

8 (b) DESCRIPTION OF ADDITION.—The parcel re-
9 ferred to in subsection (a) is the parcel generally depicted
10 on a map entitled “Slate Creek Addition-Eagles Nest Wil-
11 derness”, dated February 1997, comprising approximately
12 160 acres in Summit County, Colorado, adjacent to the
13 Eagles Nest Wilderness.
