## A BILL

To reauthorize the African Elephant Conservation Act.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. REAUTHORIZATION OF THE AFRICAN ELE-**  
4       **PHANT CONSERVATION ACT.**

5       Section 2306 of the African Elephant Conservation  
6 Act (16 U.S.C. 4245) is amended by striking “fiscal  
7 years” and all that follows through “1998” and inserting  
8 “fiscal years 1997, 1998, 1999, 2000, 2001, and 2002.”.
