## A BILL

3       **SECTION 1. ELIMINATION OF CERTIFICATE OF CITIZEN-**  
4                       **SHIP TRANSITION RULE APPLICABLE TO**  
5                       **CERTAIN CHILDREN.**

6       (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 102 of the Immigration  
7       and Nationality Technical Corrections Act of 1994 (Public  
8       Law 103–416; 108 Stat. 4307) (as amended by section

1 671(b) of the Illegal Immigration Reform and Immigrant  
2 Responsibility Act of 1996 (Public Law 104–208; 110  
3 Stat. 3009–1856)) is amended by striking subsection (e).

4 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
5 subsection (a) shall take effect as if included in the enact-  
6 ment of the Immigration and Nationality Technical Cor-  
7 rections Act of 1994.
