2 **SHIP TRANSITION RULE APPLICABLE TO**
3 **CERTAIN CHILDREN.**

4 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Section 102 of the Immigration
5 and Nationality Technical Corrections Act of 1994 (Public
6 Law 103–416; 108 Stat. 4307) (as amended by section
7 671(b) of the Illegal Immigration Reform and Immigrant
8 Responsibility Act of 1996 (Public Law 104–208; 110
9 Stat. 3009–1856)) is amended by striking subsection (e).

10 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by
11 subsection (a) shall take effect as if included in the enact-
12 ment of the Immigration and Nationality Technical Cor-
13 rections Act of 1994.
