A BILL

To redesignate the Dublin Federal Courthouse building located in Dublin, Georgia, as the J. Roy Rowland Federal Courthouse.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REDESIGNATION.**

4 The Federal building located at 100 Franklin Street
5 in Dublin, Georgia, and known as the Dublin Federal
6 Courthouse, shall be known and designated as the “J. Roy
7 Rowland Federal Courthouse”.

1 **SEC. 2. REFERENCE.**

2 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
3 paper, or other record of the United States to the Federal
4 building referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be
5 a reference to the “J. Roy Rowland Federal Courthouse”.
