## A BILL

To deny veterans benefits to persons convicted of Federal capital offenses.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DENIAL OF VETERANS BENEFITS.**

4 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a person  
5 who is convicted of a Federal or State capital offense is  
6 ineligible for benefits provided to veterans of the Armed  
7 Forces of the United States pursuant to title 38, United  
8 States Code.
