A BILL

To make technical corrections to the Omnibus Parks and Public Lands Management Act of 1996, and for other purposes.

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE AND TABLE OF CONTENTS.**

4 The table of contents in section 1 of division I of the
5 Omnibus Parks and Public Lands Management Act of
6 1996 (110 Stat. 4094; 16 U.S.C. 1 note; hereinafter re-
7 ferred to as the “Omnibus Parks Act”) is amended by
8 striking—

2 **SEC. 2. THE PRESIDIO OF SAN FRANCISCO.**

3 (a) Section 101(2) of division I of the Omnibus Parks
4 Act of 1996 (110 Stat. 4097; 16 U.S.C. 460bb note) is
5 amended by striking “the Presidio is” and inserting “the
6 Presidio was”.

7 (b) Section 103(b)(1) of division I of the Omnibus
8 Parks Act (110 Stat. 4099; 16 U.S.C. 460bb note) is
9 amended in the last sentence by striking “other lands ad-
10 ministrated by the Secretary.” and inserting “other lands
11 administered by the Secretary.”.

12 (c) Section 105(a)(2) of division I of the Omnibus

13 4401(b),” and inserting “section 8(b) of the Act referred
14 to in section 508(b),”.

15 **SEC. 9. ADVISORY COUNCIL ON HISTORIC PRESERVATION**
16 **REAUTHORIZATION.**

17 The first sentence of section 205(g) of title II of the
18 National Historic Preservation Act (16 U.S.C. 470 et
19 seq.) is amended by striking “and are otherwise available
20 for the purpose.” and inserting “and are otherwise avail-
21 able for that purpose.”.
