## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To authorize the printing of the eulogies of the Senate and the House of Representatives for Detective John Michael Gibson and Private First Class Jacob Joseph Chestnut.

1       *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*  
2 *concurring)*, That the eulogies for Detective John Michael  
3 Gibson and Private First Class Jacob Joseph Chestnut of  
4 the United States Capitol Police, as expressed in the  
5 House of Representatives and the Senate together with  
6 the text of the memorial services, shall be printed as a  
7 tribute to Detective Gibson and Officer Chestnut, with il-  
8 lustrations and suitable binding. The document shall be  
9 prepared under the direction of the Joint Committee on

1 Printing. There shall be printed 300 casebound copies; 50  
2 to be delivered to each of the families of Detective Gibson  
3 and Officer Chestnut, and 200 for the use of the United  
4 States Capitol Police.
