CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Authorizing the use of the rotunda of the Capitol for a ceremony honoring Leslie Townes (Bob) Hope by conferring upon him the status of an honorary veteran of the Armed Forces of the United States.

1 *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*
2 *concurring)*, That the rotunda of the Capitol is authorized
3 to be used on October 29, 1997, for a ceremony to honor
4 Leslie Townes (Bob) Hope by conferring upon him the
5 status of an honorary veteran of the Armed Forces of the
6 United States. Physical preparations for the conduct of
7 the ceremony shall be carried out in accordance with such

1 conditions as may be prescribed by the Architect of the
2 Capitol.
