CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*
2 *concurring)*, That (a) a revised edition of the brochure en-
3 titled “How Our Laws Are Made”, under the direction of
4 the Parliamentarian of the House of Representatives in
5 consultation with the Parliamentarian of the Senate, shall
6 be printed as a Senate document, with suitable paper
7 cover in the style selected by the chairman of the Joint
8 Committee on Printing.

9 (b) There shall be printed—

10 (1)(A) 250,000 copies of the brochure for the
11 use of the House of Representatives, distributed in
12 equal numbers to each Member;

1 (B) 100,000 copies of the brochure for the use
2 of the Senate, distributed in equal numbers to each
3 Member;

4 (C) 2,000 copies of the brochure for the use of
5 the Joint Committee on Printing; and

6 (D) 1,400 copies of the brochure for distribu-
7 tion to the depository libraries; or

8 (2) if the total printing and production costs of
9 copies in paragraph (1) exceed \$180,000, such num-
10 ber of copies of the brochure as does not exceed total
11 printing and production costs of \$180,000, with dis-
12 tribution to be allocated in the same proportion as
13 in paragraph (1).
