Mr. REID submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the
Committee on the Judiciary

RESOLUTION

Designating December 13, 1998, as “National Children’s
Memorial Day”.

Whereas approximately 79,000 infants, children, teenagers,
and young adults die each year in the United States;

Whereas the death of a child is one of the greatest tragedies
suffered by a family; and

Whereas support and understanding are critical to the heal-
ing process of a bereaved family: Now, therefore, be it

1 *Resolved*, That the Senate—

2 (1) designates December 13, 1998, as “Na-
3 tional Children’s Memorial Day”; and

4 (2) requests that the President issue a procla-
5 mation designating December 13, 1998, as “Na-
6 tional Children’s Memorial Day” and calls on the

1 people of the United States to observe the day with
2 appropriate ceremonies and activities in remem-
3 brance of infants, children, teenagers, and young
4 adults who have died.
