## RESOLUTION

Designating December 13, 1998, as “National Children’s  
Memorial Day”.

Whereas approximately 79,000 infants, children, teenagers,  
and young adults die each year in the United States;

Whereas the death of a child is one of the greatest tragedies  
suffered by a family; and

Whereas support and understanding are critical to the heal-  
ing process of a bereaved family: Now, therefore, be it

1       *Resolved*, That the Senate—

2               (1) designates December 13, 1998, as “Na-

3       tional Children’s Memorial Day”; and

1           (2) requests that the President issue a procla-  
2           mation designating December 13, 1998, as “Na-  
3           tional Children’s Memorial Day” and calls on the  
4           people of the United States to observe the day with  
5           appropriate ceremonies and activities in remem-  
6           brance of infants, children, teenagers, and young  
7           adults who have died.
