## RESOLUTION

Commending Senator Robert Byrd for fifty years of public service.

Whereas the Honorable Robert C. Byrd has dutifully and faithfully served the people of West Virginia since January 8, 1947;

Whereas, for 50 years, he had dedicated himself to improving the lives and welfare of the people of West Virginia and the United States,

Whereas his 50-year commitment of public service has been one of total dedication to serving the people of his beloved State and to the highest ideals of public service,

Whereas he has held more legislative offices than anyone else in the history of his State, and is the longest serving Senator in the history of his State: Now, therefore, be it

1        *Resolved*, That the United States Senate congratu-  
2 lates the Honorable Robert C. Byrd, the senior Senator  
3 from West Virginia, for his 50 years of public service to  
4 the people of West Virginia and to the United States of
