

In the Senate of the United States,

November 19, 1999.

Resolved, That the resolution from the House of Representatives (H. Con. Res. 221) entitled “Concurrent resolution authorizing printing of the brochures entitled “How Our Laws Are Made” and “Our American Government”, the pocket version of the United States Constitution, and the document-sized, annotated version of the United States Constitution.”, do pass with the following

AMENDMENT:

Strike out all after the resolving clause and insert:

1 **SECTION 1. OUR AMERICAN GOVERNMENT.**

2 (a) *IN GENERAL.*—*The 1999 revised edition of the bro-*
3 *chure entitled “Our American Government” shall be print-*
4 *ed as a House document under the direction of the Joint*
5 *Committee on Printing.*

6 (b) *ADDITIONAL COPIES.*—*In addition to the usual*
7 *number, there shall be printed the lesser of—*

8 (1) *550,000 copies of the document, of which*
9 *440,000 copies shall be for the use of the House of*

1 *Representatives, 100,000 copies shall be for the use of*
2 *the Senate, and 10,000 copies shall be for the use of*
3 *the Joint Committee on Printing; or*

4 (2) *such number of copies of the document as*
5 *does not exceed a total production and printing cost*
6 *of \$412,873, with distribution to be allocated in the*
7 *same proportion as described in paragraph (1), except*
8 *that in no case shall the number of copies be less than*
9 *1 per Member of Congress.*

10 **SEC. 2. DOCUMENT-SIZED, ANNOTATED UNITED STATES**
11 **CONSTITUTION.**

12 (a) *IN GENERAL.*—*The 1999 edition of the document-*
13 *sized, annotated version of the United States Constitution*
14 *shall be printed as a House document under the direction*
15 *of the Joint Committee on Printing.*

16 (b) *ADDITIONAL COPIES.*—*In addition to the usual*
17 *number, there shall be printed the lesser of—*

18 (1) *550,000 copies of the document, of which*
19 *440,000 copies shall be for the use of the House of*
20 *Representatives, 100,000 copies shall be for the use of*
21 *the Senate, and 10,000 copies shall be for the use of*
22 *the Joint Committee on Printing; or*

23 (2) *such number of copies of the document as*
24 *does not exceed a total production and printing cost*
25 *of \$393,316, with distribution to be allocated in the*

1 *same proportion as described in paragraph (1), except*
2 *that in no case shall the number of copies be less than*
3 *1 per Member of Congress.*

4 **SEC. 3. HOW OUR LAWS ARE MADE.**

5 (a) *IN GENERAL.*—*An edition of the brochure entitled*
6 *“How Our Laws Are Made”, as revised under the direction*
7 *of the Parliamentarian of the House of Representatives in*
8 *consultation with the Parliamentarian of the Senate, shall*
9 *be printed as a House document under the direction of the*
10 *Joint Committee on Printing.*

11 (b) *ADDITIONAL COPIES.*—*In addition to the usual*
12 *number, there shall be printed the lesser of—*

13 (1) *550,000 copies of the document, of which*
14 *440,000 copies shall be for the use of the House of*
15 *Representatives, 100,000 copies shall be for the use of*
16 *the Senate, and 10,000 copies shall be for the use of*
17 *the Joint Committee on Printing; or*

18 (2) *such number of copies of the document as*
19 *does not exceed a total production and printing cost*
20 *of \$200,722, with distribution to be allocated in the*
21 *same proportion as described in paragraph (1), except*
22 *that in no case shall the number of copies be less than*
23 *1 per Member of Congress.*

1 **SEC. 4. POCKET VERSION OF THE UNITED STATES CON-**
 2 **STITUTION.**

3 (a) *IN GENERAL.*—*The 20th edition of the pocket*
 4 *version of the United States Constitution shall be printed*
 5 *as a House document under the direction of the Joint Com-*
 6 *mittee on Printing.*

7 (b) *ADDITIONAL COPIES.*—*In addition to the usual*
 8 *number, there shall be printed the lesser of—*

9 (1) *550,000 copies of the document, of which*
 10 *440,000 copies shall be for the use of the House of*
 11 *Representatives, 100,000 copies shall be for the use of*
 12 *the Senate, and 10,000 copies shall be for the use of*
 13 *the Joint Committee on Printing; or*

14 (2) *such number of copies of the document as*
 15 *does not exceed a total production and printing cost*
 16 *of \$115,208, with distribution to be allocated in the*
 17 *same proportion as described in paragraph (1), except*
 18 *that in no case shall the number of copies be less than*
 19 *1 per Member of Congress.*

20 **SEC. 5. CAPITOL BUILDER: THE SHORTHAND JOURNALS OF**
 21 **CAPTAIN MONTGOMERY C. MEIGS, 1853–1861.**

22 (a) *IN GENERAL.*—*There shall be printed as a Senate*
 23 *document the book entitled “Capitol Builder: The Short-*
 24 *hand Journals of Captain Montgomery C. Meigs, 1853–*
 25 *1861”, prepared under the direction of the Secretary of the*

1 *Senate, in consultation with the Clerk of the House of Rep-*
 2 *resentatives and the Architect of the Capitol.*

3 (b) *SPECIFICATIONS.*—*The Senate document described*
 4 *in subsection (a) shall include illustrations and shall be in*
 5 *the style, form, manner, and binding as directed by the*
 6 *Joint Committee on Printing after consultation with the*
 7 *Secretary of the Senate.*

8 (c) *NUMBER OF COPIES.*—*In addition to the usual*
 9 *number of copies, there shall be printed with suitable bind-*
 10 *ing the lesser of—*

11 (1) *1,500 copies for the use of the Senate, the*
 12 *House of Representatives, and the Architect of the*
 13 *Capitol, to be allocated as determined by the Sec-*
 14 *retary of the Senate and the Clerk of the House of*
 15 *Representatives; or*

16 (2) *a number of copies that does not have a total*
 17 *production and printing cost of more than \$31,500.*

18 **SEC. 6. THE UNITED STATES CAPITOL: A CHRONICLE OF**
 19 **CONSTRUCTION, DESIGN, AND POLITICS.**

20 (a) *IN GENERAL.*—*There shall be printed as a Senate*
 21 *document the book entitled “The United States Capitol: A*
 22 *Chronicle of Construction, Design, and Politics”, prepared*
 23 *by the Architect of the Capitol.*

24 (b) *SPECIFICATIONS.*—*The Senate document described*
 25 *in subsection (a) shall include illustrations and shall be in*

1 *the style, form, manner, and binding as directed by the*
2 *Joint Committee on Printing after consultation with the*
3 *Secretary of the Senate.*

4 (c) *NUMBER OF COPIES.—In addition to the usual*
5 *number of copies, there shall be printed with suitable bind-*
6 *ing the lesser of—*

7 (1) *6,500 copies for the use of the Senate, the*
8 *House of Representatives, and the Architect of the*
9 *Capitol, to be allocated as determined by the Sec-*
10 *retary of the Senate; or*

11 (2) *a number of copies that does not have a total*
12 *production and printing cost of more than \$143,000.*
