CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Directing the Clerk of the House of Representatives to make a technical correction in the enrollment of the bill H.R. 3194.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That in the enrollment of the bill (H.R.
3 3194), making appropriations for the government of the
4 District of Columbia and other activities chargeable in
5 whole or in part against revenues of said District for the
6 fiscal year ending September 30, 2000, and for other pur-
7 poses, the Clerk of the House of Representatives shall in-

1 sert before the comma at the end of section 1000(a)(7)
2 of division B the following: “, except that subsection (c)
3 of section 912 of H.R. 3427 shall be deemed to read as
4 follows:

5 ‘(c) ADVANCE CONGRESSIONAL NOTIFICATION.—

6 ‘(1) FISCAL YEAR 1998.—Funds made available
7 pursuant to section 911(a)(1) may be obligated and
8 expended beginning on or after December 15, 1999,
9 provided that the appropriate certification has been
10 submitted to the appropriate congressional commit-
11 tees.

12 ‘(2) FISCAL YEARS 1999 AND 2000.—Funds
13 made available pursuant to paragraph (2) or (3) of
14 section 911(a) may be obligated and expended only
15 if the appropriate certification has been submitted to
16 the appropriate congressional committees 30 days
17 prior to the payment of the funds’”.

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
