

In the Senate of the United States,

June 23, 2000.

Resolved, That the resolution from the House of Representatives (H. Con. Res. 251) entitled “Concurrent resolution commending the Republic of Croatia for the conduct of its parliamentary and presidential elections.”, do pass with the following

AMENDMENTS:

Strike out all after the resolving clause and insert:

1 *That it is the sense of Congress that—*

2 *(1) the people of the Republic of Croatia are to*
3 *be congratulated on the successful elections and the*
4 *outgoing Government of Croatia is to be commended*
5 *for the democratic standards with which it managed*
6 *the elections;*

7 *(2) the United States should support the efforts*
8 *of the new Government of Croatia to increase its work*
9 *on refugee return, privatization reform, media reform,*
10 *and further cooperation with the International Crimi-*

1 *nal Tribunal for Former Yugoslavia (ICTY) to set an*
2 *example to other countries in the region;*

3 *(3) Congress strongly supports Croatia's commit-*
4 *ment to western democratic standards and will give*
5 *its full support to the new Government of Croatia to*
6 *fully implement democratic reforms; and*

7 *(4) the United States continues to promote Cro-*
8 *atian-American economic, political, and military re-*
9 *lations and recognizes Croatia as a loyal partner in*
10 *south central Europe.*

Amend the preamble as follows:

Page 2, first unnumbered line, strike out **[landslide]**
