Mr. LAZIO submitted the following concurrent resolution; which was considered and agreed to

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for an adjournment or recess of the two Houses.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That when the House adjourns on the legisla-
3 tive day of Friday, February 12, 1999, it stand adjourned
4 until 12:30 p.m. on Tuesday, February 23, 1999, or until
5 noon on the second day after Members are notified to reas-
6 semble pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution,
7 whichever occurs first; and that when the Senate recesses
8 or adjourns at the close of business on Thursday, Feb-
9 ruary 11, 1999, Friday, February 12, 1999, Saturday,
10 February 13, 1999, or Sunday, February 14, 1999, pursu-
11 ant to a motion made by the Majority Leader, or his des-
12 ignee, pursuant to this concurrent resolution, it stand re-

1 cessed or adjourned until noon on Monday, February 22,
2 1999, or such time on that day as may be specified by
3 the Majority Leader or his designee in the motion to recess
4 or adjourn, or until noon on the second day after Members
5 are notified to reassemble pursuant to section 2 of this
6 concurrent resolution, whichever occurs first.

7 SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority
8 Leader of the Senate, acting jointly after consultation with
9 the Minority Leader of the House and the Minority Lead-
10 er of the Senate, shall notify the Members of the House
11 and the Senate, respectively, to reassemble whenever, in
12 their opinion, the public interest shall warrant it.
