CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That when the House adjourns on the legisla-
3 tive day of Friday, February 12, 1999, it stand adjourned
4 until 12:30 p.m. on Tuesday, February 23, 1999, or until
5 noon on the second day after Members are notified to reas-

1 semble pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution,
2 whichever occurs first; and that when the Senate recesses
3 or adjourns at the close of business on Thursday, Feb-
4 ruary 11, 1999, Friday, February 12, 1999, Saturday,
5 February 13, 1999, or Sunday, February 14, 1999, pursu-
6 ant to a motion made by the Majority Leader, or his des-
7 ignee, pursuant to this concurrent resolution, it stand re-
8 cessed or adjourned until noon on Monday, February 22,
9 1999, or such time on that day as may be specified by
10 the Majority Leader or his designee in the motion to recess
11 or adjourn, or until noon on the second day after Members
12 are notified to reassemble pursuant to section 2 of this
13 concurrent resolution, whichever occurs first.

14 SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority
15 Leader of the Senate, acting jointly after consultation with
16 the Minority Leader of the House and the Minority Lead-
17 er of the Senate, shall notify the Members of the House
18 and the Senate, respectively, to reassemble whenever, in
19 their opinion, the public interest shall warrant it.
