Mr. LINDER submitted the following concurrent resolution; which was
considered and agreed to

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for a conditional adjournment of the House of
Representatives and a conditional recess or adjournment
of the Senate.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That when the House adjourns on the legisla-
3 tive day of Thursday, May 25, 2000, or Friday, May 26,
4 2000, on a motion offered pursuant to this concurrent res-
5 olution by its Majority Leader or his designee, it stand
6 adjourned until 10:30 a.m. on Tuesday, June 6, 2000, for
7 morning-hour debate, or until noon on the second day
8 after Members are notified to reassemble pursuant to sec-
9 tion 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever occurs first;
10 and that when the Senate recesses or adjourns at the close

1 of business on Thursday, May 25, 2000, Friday, May 26,
2 2000, Saturday, May 27, 2000, or Sunday, May 28, 2000,
3 on a motion offered pursuant to this concurrent resolution
4 by its Majority Leader or his designee, it stand recessed
5 or adjourned until noon on Monday, June 5, 2000, or
6 Tuesday, June 6, 2000, as may be specified by its Major-
7 ity Leader or his designee in the motion to recess or ad-
8 journ, or at such other time on that day as may be speci-
9 fied by its Majority Leader or his designee in the motion,
10 or until noon on the second day after Members are notified
11 to reassemble pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent res-
12 olution, whichever occurs first.

13 SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority
14 Leader of the Senate, acting jointly after consultation with
15 the Minority Leader of the House and the Minority Lead-
16 er of the Senate, shall notify the Members of the House
17 and the Senate, respectively, to reassemble whenever, in
18 their opinion, the public interest shall warrant it.
