## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Expressing the sense of Congress that the Supreme Court misinterpreted the First Amendment to the Constitution in the case of *Buckley v. Valeo*.

1       *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*  
2 *concurring)*, That it is the sense of Congress that the Su-  
3 preme Court misinterpreted the First Amendment to the  
4 Constitution in its decision in the 1976 case of *Buckley*  
5 *v. Valeo* because—

6           (1) the decision failed to recognize that the un-  
7 limited spending of large amounts of money on elec-  
8 tions has a corrosive effect on the electoral process  
9 not simply because of direct transactions between  
10 those who give large amounts of money and can-

1 didates and elected officials but because the presence  
2 of unlimited amounts of money corrupts the process  
3 on a more fundamental level; and

4 (2) the decision failed to recognize other legiti-  
5 mate state interests which justify limiting money in  
6 campaigns, including the need to preserve the integ-  
7 rity of our republican form of government, restore  
8 public confidence in government, and ensure all citi-  
9 zens a more equal opportunity to participate in the  
10 political process.
