CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for corrections in the enrollment of the bill (H.R. 5164) amending title 49, United States Code, to require reports concerning defects in motor vehicles or tires or other motor vehicle equipment in foreign countries, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That in the enrollment of the bill, H.R. 5164,
3 entitled “An Act to amend title 49, United States Code,
4 to require reports concerning defects in motor vehicles or
5 tires or other motor vehicle equipment in foreign coun-

1 tries, and for other purposes”, the Clerk of the House of
2 Representatives shall make the following corrections in
3 section 6:

4 (1) insert before “Section 30120(c)” the fol-
5 lowing: “(a) REMEDY PROGRAM.—”; and

6 (2) insert at the end of section 6 the following:
7 “(b) REIMBURSEMENT PRIOR TO RECALL.—Section
8 30120(d) of title 49, United States Code, is amended by
9 inserting at the end thereof the following: “A manufactur-
10 er’s remedy program shall include a plan for reimbursing
11 an owner or purchaser who incurred the cost of the rem-
12 edy within a reasonable time in advance of the manufac-
13 turer’s notification under subsection (b) or (c) of section
14 30118. The Secretary may prescribe regulations estab-
15 lishing what constitutes a reasonable time for purposes of
16 the preceding sentence and other reasonable conditions for
17 the reimbursement plan.”.
