Mr. ARMEY submitted the following concurrent resolution; which was
considered and agreed to

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for a conditional adjournment of the House of
Representatives and a conditional recess or adjournment
of the Senate.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That when the House adjourns on the legisla-
3 tive day of Tuesday, November 14, 2000, or Wednesday,
4 November 15, 2000, on a motion offered pursuant to this
5 concurrent resolution by its Majority Leader or his des-
6 ignee, it stand adjourned until 2 p.m. on Monday, Decem-
7 ber 4, 2000, or until noon on the second day after Mem-
8 bers are notified to reassemble pursuant to section 2 of
9 this concurrent resolution, whichever occurs first; and that
10 when the Senate recesses or adjourns at the close of busi-

1 ness on Tuesday, November 14, 2000, or Wednesday, No-
2 vember 15, 2000, on a motion offered pursuant to this
3 concurrent resolution by its Majority Leader or his des-
4 ignee, it stand recessed or adjourned until noon on Tues-
5 day, December 5, 2000, or until such time on that day
6 as may be specified by its Majority Leader or his designee
7 in the motion to recess or adjourn, or until noon on the
8 second day after Members are notified to reassemble pur-
9 suant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever
10 occurs first.

11 SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority
12 Leader of the Senate, acting jointly after consultation with
13 the Minority Leader of the House and the Minority Lead-
14 er of the Senate, shall notify the Members of the House
15 and the Senate, respectively, to reassemble whenever, in
16 their opinion, the public interest shall warrant it.
