## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for a conditional adjournment of the House of Representatives and a conditional recess or adjournment of the Senate.

1        *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*  
2 *concurring)*, That when the House adjourns on the legisla-  
3 tive day of Tuesday, November 14, 2000, or Wednesday,  
4 November 15, 2000, on a motion offered pursuant to this  
5 concurrent resolution by its Majority Leader or his

1 designee, it stand adjourned until 2 p.m. on Monday, De-  
2 cember 4, 2000, or until noon on the second day after  
3 Members are notified to reassemble pursuant to section  
4 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever occurs first; and  
5 that when the Senate recesses or adjourns at the close  
6 of business on Tuesday, November 14, 2000, or Wednes-  
7 day, November 15, 2000, on a motion offered pursuant  
8 to this concurrent resolution by its Majority Leader or his  
9 designee, it stand recessed or adjourned until noon on  
10 Tuesday, December 5, 2000, or until such time on that  
11 day as may be specified by its Majority Leader or his des-  
12 ignee in the motion to recess or adjourn, or until noon  
13 on the second day after Members are notified to reassem-  
14 ble pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution,  
15 whichever occurs first.

16       SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority  
17 Leader of the Senate, acting jointly after consultation with  
18 the Minority Leader of the House and the Minority Lead-  
19 er of the Senate, shall notify the Members of the House  
20 and the Senate, respectively, to reassemble whenever, in  
21 their opinion, the public interest shall warrant it.
