## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for the sine die adjournment of the second session  
of the One Hundred Sixth Congress.

1        *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*  
2   *concurring)*, That when the House adjourns on the legisla-  
3   tive day of Friday, December 15, 2000, Saturday, Decem-  
4   ber 16, 2000, or Sunday, December 17, 2000, on a motion  
5   offered pursuant to this concurrent resolution by its

1 Majority Leader or his designee, it shall stand adjourned  
2 sine die, or until noon on the second day after Members  
3 are notified to reassemble pursuant to section 2 of this  
4 concurrent resolution; and that when the Senate adjourns  
5 on Friday, December 15, 2000, Saturday, December 16,  
6 2000, or Sunday, December 17, 2000, on a motion offered  
7 pursuant to this concurrent resolution by its Majority  
8 Leader or his designee, it shall stand adjourned sine die,  
9 or until noon on the second day after Members are notified  
10 to reassemble pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent res-  
11 olution.

12       SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority  
13 Leader of the Senate, acting jointly after consultation with  
14 the Minority Leader of the House and the Minority Lead-  
15 er of the Senate, shall notify the Members of the House  
16 and Senate, respectively, to reassemble whenever, in their  
17 opinion, the public interest shall warrant it.
