CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Authorizing the use of the Capitol Grounds for a bike rodeo to be conducted by the Earth Force Youth Bike Summit.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring),*

1 (b) ADDITIONAL ARRANGEMENTS.—The Architect of
2 the Capitol and the Capitol Police Board are authorized
3 to make any such additional arrangements as may be re-
4 quired to carry out the event.

5 **SEC. 4. ENFORCEMENT OF RESTRICTIONS.**

6 The Capitol Police Board shall provide for enforce-
7 ment of the restrictions contained in section 4 of the Act
8 of July 31, 1946 (40 U.S.C. 193d; 60 Stat. 718), concern-
9 ing sales, displays, and solicitations on the Capitol
10 Grounds, as well as other restrictions applicable to the
11 Capitol Grounds, with respect to the event authorized by
12 section 1.

13 **SEC. 5. LIMITATIONS ON REPRESENTATIONS.**

14 (a) IN GENERAL.—No person may represent, either
15 directly or indirectly, that this resolution or any activity
16 carried out under this resolution in any way constitutes
17 approval or endorsement by the Federal Government of
18 any person or any product or service.

19 (b) ENFORCEMENT.—The Architect of the Capitol
20 and the Capitol Police Board shall enter into an agree-
21 ment with the sponsor, and such other persons participat-
22 ing in the event authorized by section 1 as the Architect
23 of the Capitol and the Capitol Police Board considers ap-
24 propriate, under which such persons shall agree to comply
25 with the requirements of subsection (a). The agreement

1 shall specifically prohibit the use of any photograph taken
2 at the event for a commercial purpose and shall provide
3 for the imposition of financial penalties if any violations
4 of the agreement occur.
