A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Agriculture to convey certain National Forest lands to Elko County, Nevada, for continued use as a cemetery.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CONVEYANCE OF NATIONAL FOREST LANDS TO**
4 **ELKO COUNTY, NEVADA, FOR USE AS CEME-**
5 **TERY.**

6 (a) REQUIREMENT TO CONVEY.—The Secretary of
7 Agriculture shall convey, without consideration, to Elko
8 County, Nevada, all right, title, and interest of the United
9 States in and to the parcel of real property described in
10 subsection (b), for use as a cemetery.

1 (b) DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY.—

2 (1) IN GENERAL.—The property referred to in
3 subsection (a) is a parcel of National Forest lands
4 (including any improvements thereon) in Elko Coun-
5 ty, Nevada, known as Jarbidge Cemetery, consisting
6 of approximately 2 acres and described as follows:
7 NE¹/₄SW¹/₄NW¹/₄, S. 9 T. 46 N, R. 58 E.,
8 MDB&M.

9 (2) SURVEY.—The exact acreage and legal de-
10 scription of the property to be conveyed under sub-
11 section (a) shall be determined by a survey satisfac-
12 tory to the Secretary. As a condition of any convey-
13 ance under this section, the Secretary shall require
14 that the cost of the survey shall be borne by the
15 County.

16 (c) ADDITIONAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS.—The
17 Secretary may require such additional terms and condi-
18 tions with respect to the conveyance under subsection (a)
19 as the Secretary considers appropriate to protect the inter-
20 ests of the United States.
