AN ACT

To direct the Secretary of Agriculture to convey certain
National Forest lands to Elko County, Nevada, for con-
tinued use as a cemetery.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. CONVEYANCE OF NATIONAL FOREST LANDS TO**
2 **ELKO COUNTY, NEVADA, FOR USE AS CEME-**
3 **TERY.**

4 (a) **REQUIREMENT TO CONVEY.**—The Secretary of
5 Agriculture shall convey, without consideration, to Elko
6 County, Nevada, all right, title, and interest of the United
7 States in and to the real property described in subsection
8 (b).

9 (b) **DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY.**—

10 (1) **IN GENERAL.**—The property referred to in
11 subsection (a) consists of: (A) a parcel of National
12 Forest lands (including any improvements thereon)
13 in Elko County, Nevada, known as Jarbidge Ceme-
14 tery, consisting of approximately 2 acres within the
15 following described lands: NE¹/₄ SW¹/₄ NW¹/₄, S. 9
16 T. 46 N, R. 58 E., MDB&M, which shall be used
17 as a cemetery; and (B) the existing bridge over the
18 Jarbidge River that provides access to that parcel,
19 and the road from the bridge to the parcel as de-
20 picted on the map entitled ‘Elko County Road and
21 Bridge Conveyance’ dated July 27, 1999.

22 (2) **SURVEY.**—The exact acreage and legal de-
23 scription of the property to be conveyed under sub-
24 section (a) shall be determined by a survey satisfac-
25 tory to the Secretary. As a condition of any convey-
26 ance under this section, the Secretary shall require

1 that the cost of the survey shall be borne by the
2 County.

3 (c) **ADDITIONAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS.**—The
4 Secretary may require such additional terms and condi-
5 tions with respect to the conveyance under subsection (a)
6 as the Secretary considers appropriate to protect the inter-
7 ests of the United States, except that the Secretary may
8 not retain for the United States any reversionary interest
9 in property conveyed under this section.
