1 **SECTION 1. INCREASE IN THE MANDATORY MINIMUM PEN-**
2 **ALTIES PROVIDED FOR POSSESSING, BRAN-**
3 **DISHING, OR DISCHARGING A FIREARM DUR-**
4 **ING AND IN RELATION TO A CRIME OF VIO-**
5 **LENCE OR DRUG TRAFFICKING CRIME.**

6 Section 924(c)(1)(A) of title 18, United States Code,
7 is amended—

8 (1) in clause (i), by striking “5” and inserting
9 “10”;

10 (2) in clause (ii), by striking “7” and inserting
11 “15”; and

12 (3) in clause (iii), by striking “10” and insert-
13 ing “20”.
