

In the Senate of the United States,

November 19, 1999.

Resolved, That the bill from the House of Representatives (H.R. 1377) entitled “An Act to designate the facility of the United States Postal Service at 13234 South Baltimore Avenue in Chicago, Illinois, as the ‘John J. Buchanan Post Office Building’.”, do pass with the following

AMENDMENTS:

Strike out all after the enacting clause and insert:

1 ***SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.***

2 *The facility of the United States Postal Service, located*
3 *at 9308 South Chicago Avenue, Chicago, Illinois, 60617, is*
4 *designated as the “John J. Buchanan Post Office Build-*
5 *ing”.*

6 ***SEC. 2. REFERENCES.***

7 *Any reference in a law, regulation, map, document,*
8 *paper, or other record of the United States to the facility*
9 *referred to in section 1 shall be considered to be a reference*
10 *to the “John J. Buchanan Post Office Building”.*

Amend the title so as to read: “An Act to designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 9308 South Chicago Avenue, Chicago, Illinois, as the ‘John J. Buchanan Post Office Building’.”.
