A BILL

To amend the Occupational Safety and Health Act of 1970.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. MEETINGS WITH EMPLOYEES.**

4 Section 4 of the Occupational Safety and Health Act
5 of 1970 (29 U.S.C. 652) is amended by adding at the end
6 the following:

7 “(c) Notwithstanding section 8(a)(2) of the National
8 Labor Relations Act, an employer may deal with employ-
9 ees of the employer in any capacity to identify and evalu-
10 ate safety-related conditions in the workplace, to propose,
11 review, evaluate, and implement workplace safety and

- 1 health rules and policies, and to assist the employer in
- 2 compliance with the requirements of this Act.”.
