2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

4 The facility of the United States Postal Service lo-
5 cated at 200 East Pinckney Street in Madison, Florida,
6 is hereby designated as the “Captain Colin P. Kelly, Jr.

1 Post Office”. Any reference to such facility in a law, regu-
2 lation, map, document, paper, or other record of the
3 United States shall be considered to be a reference to the
4 “Captain Colin P. Kelly, Jr. Post Office”.
